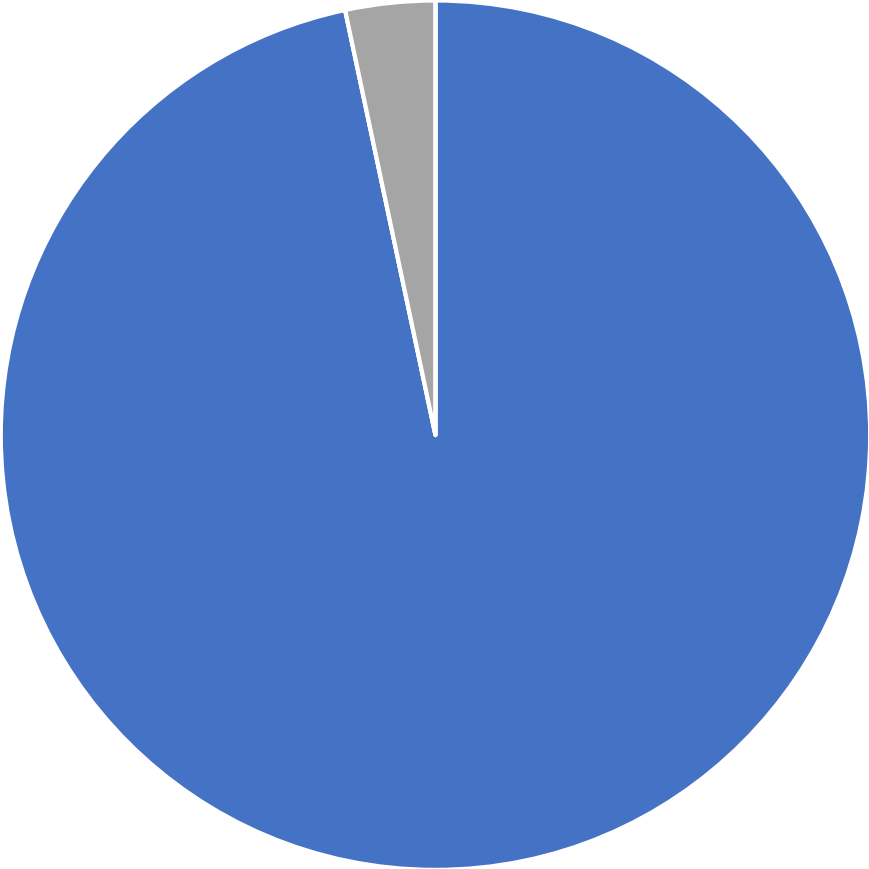

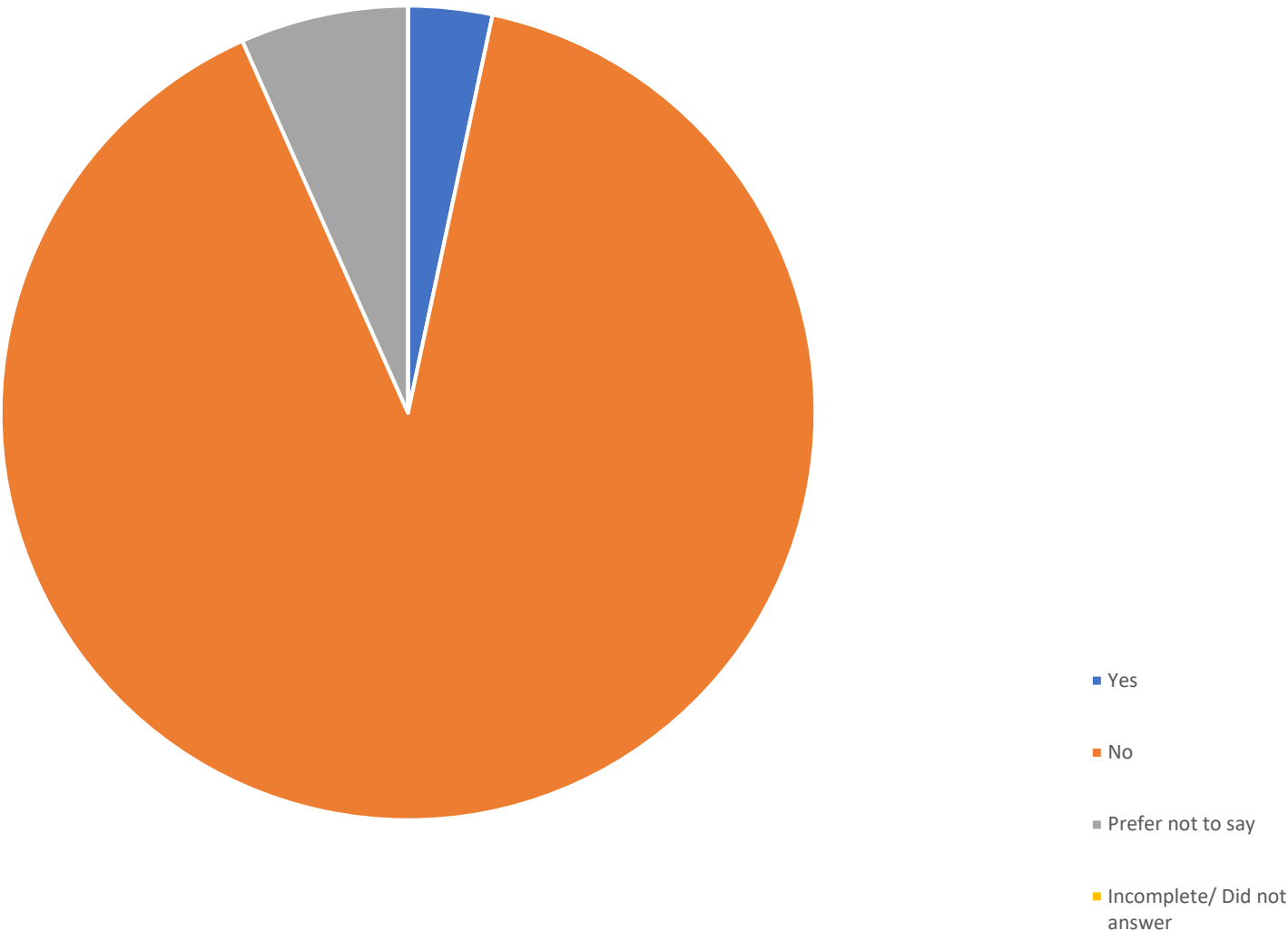

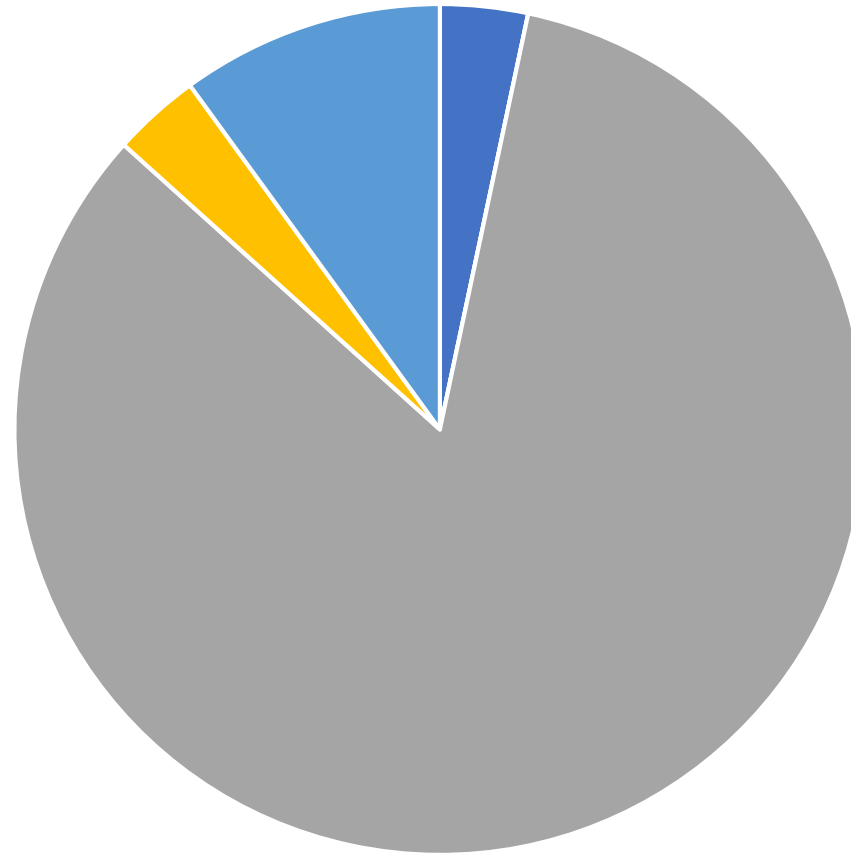

Disabilities according to the definition in the Equality Act 2010

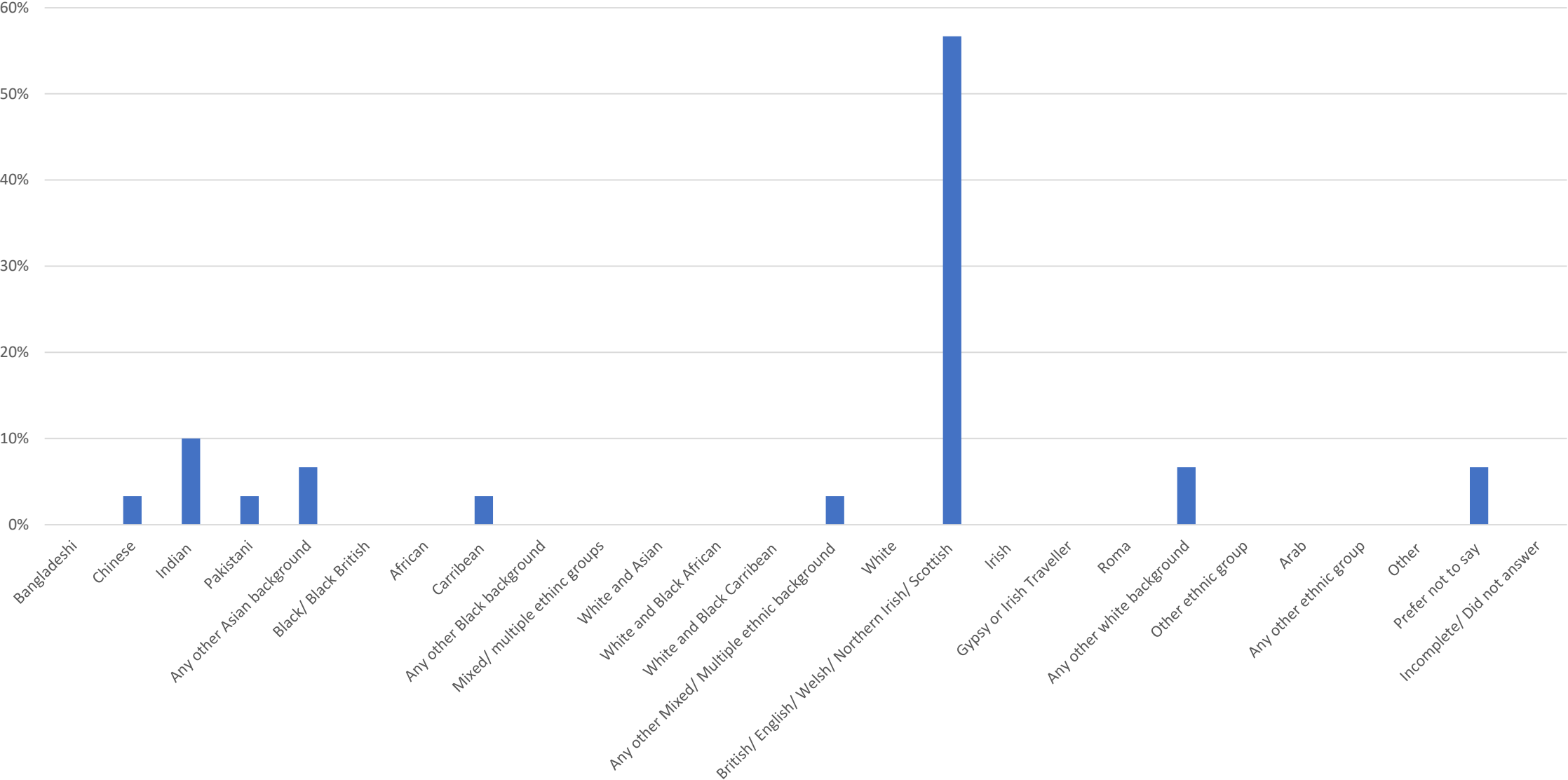


Limitations with day to day activities by disability or condition

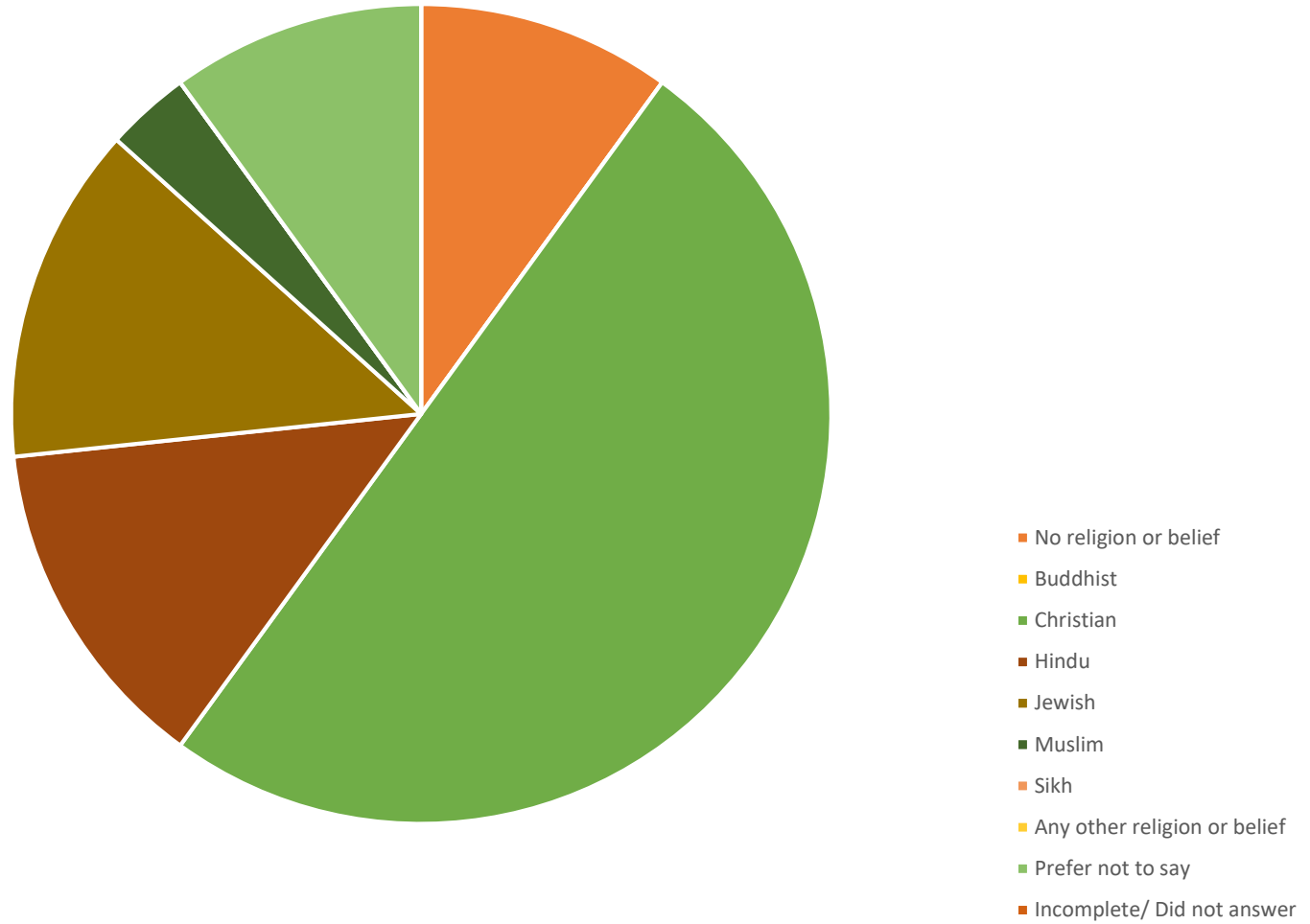

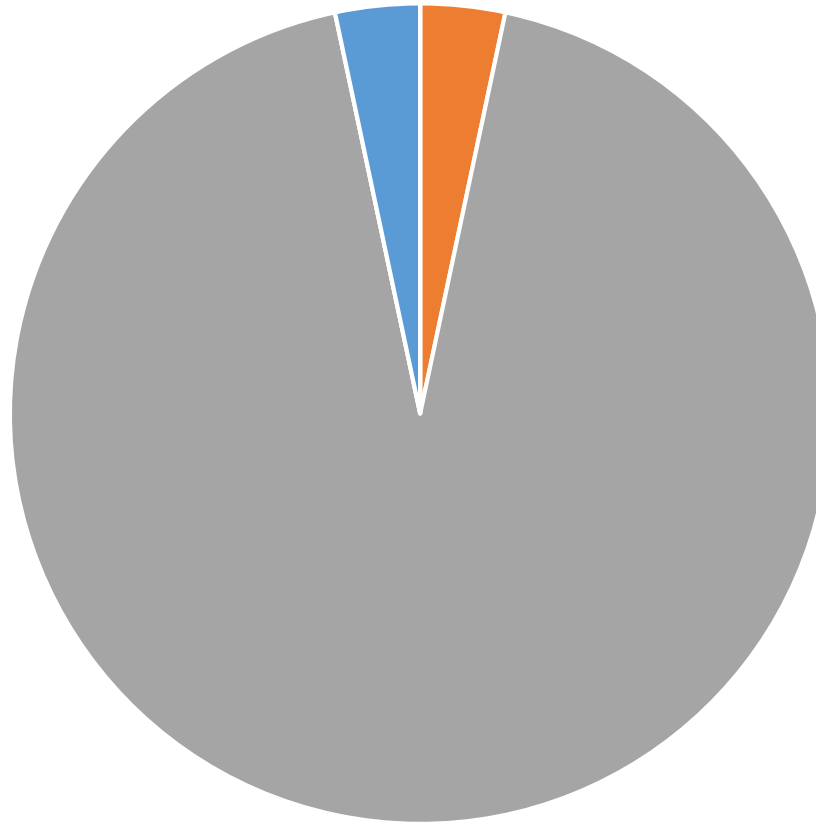
Ethnicity



Religion or Belief

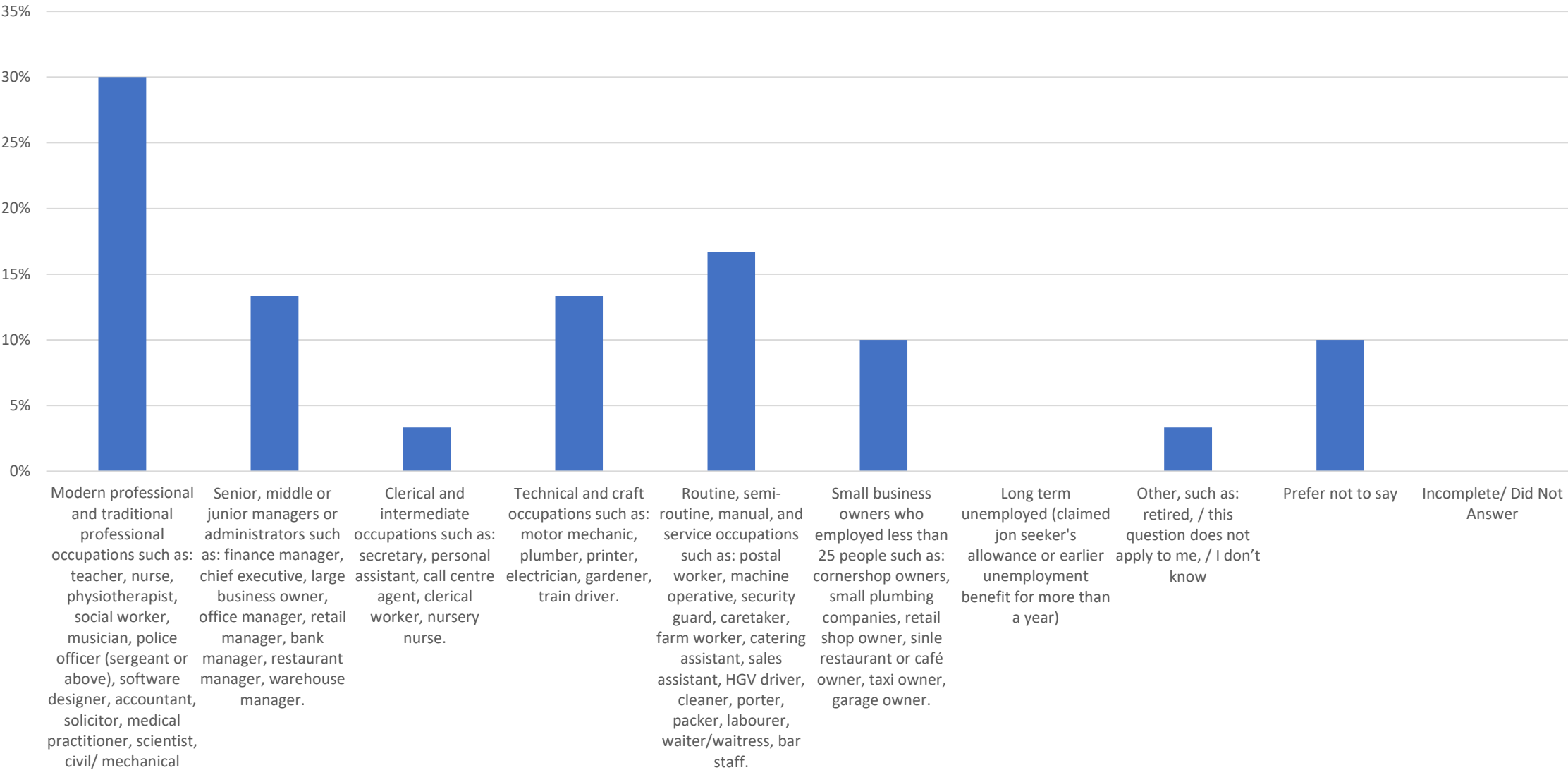


Sexual Orientation

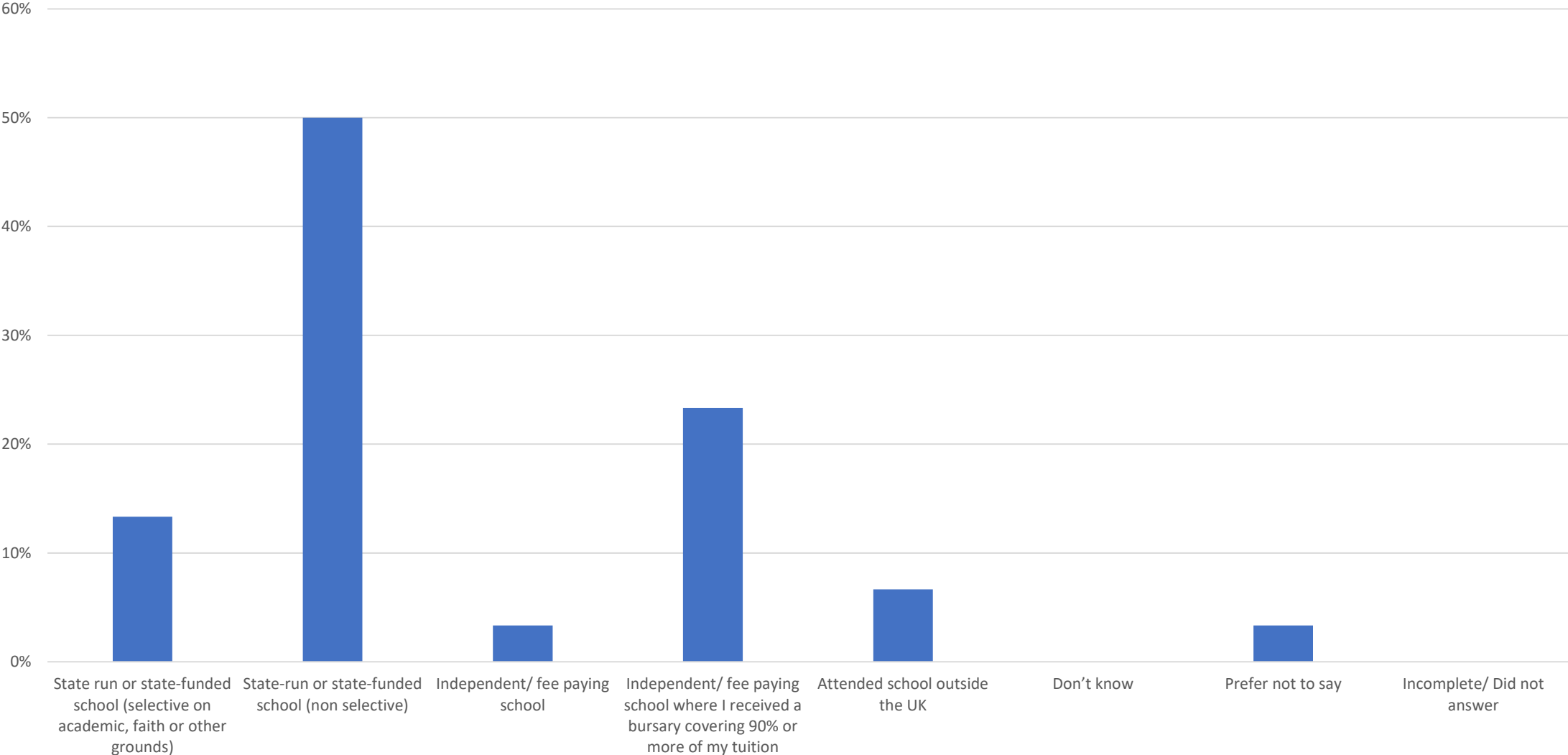

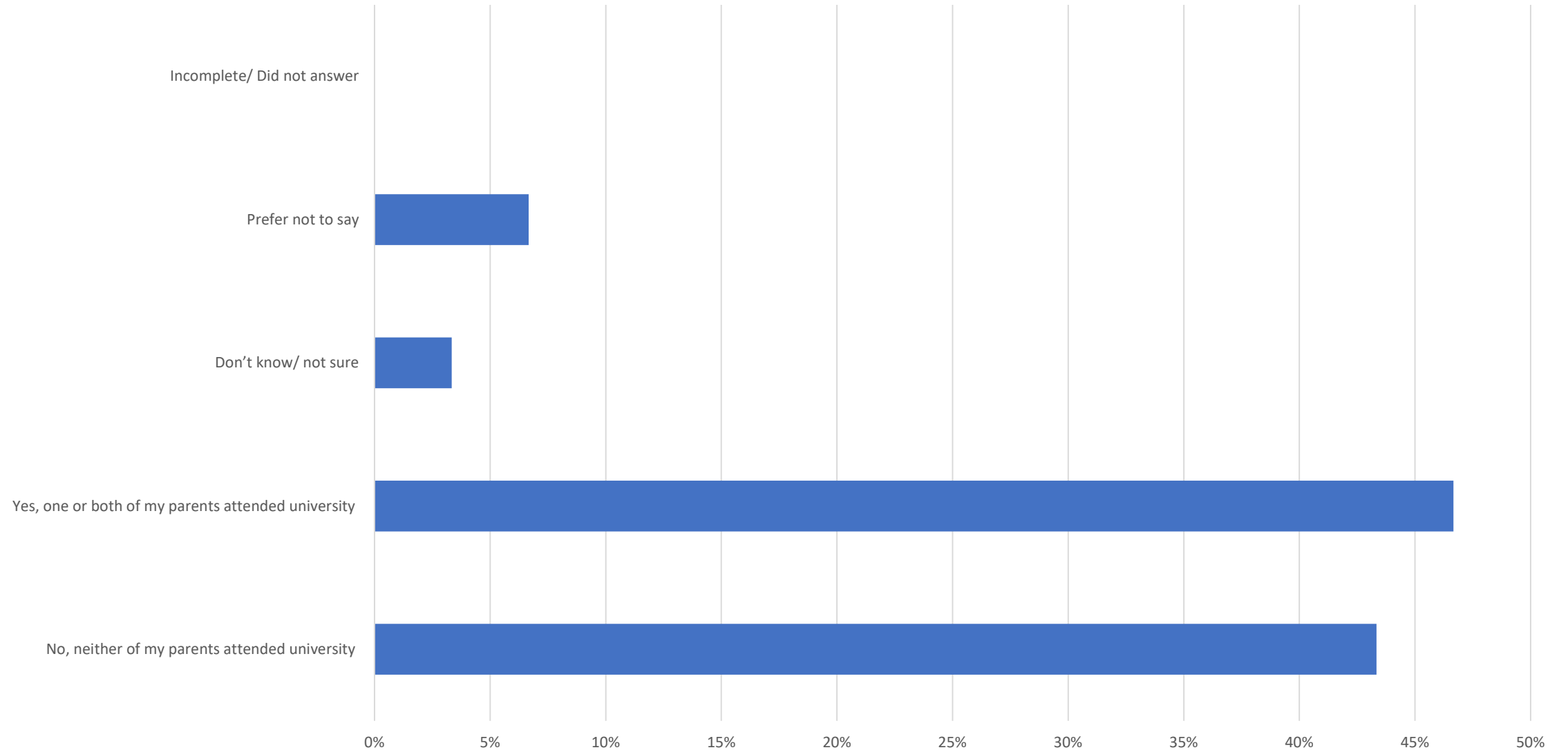
Occupation of mainhousehold earner when aged about 14



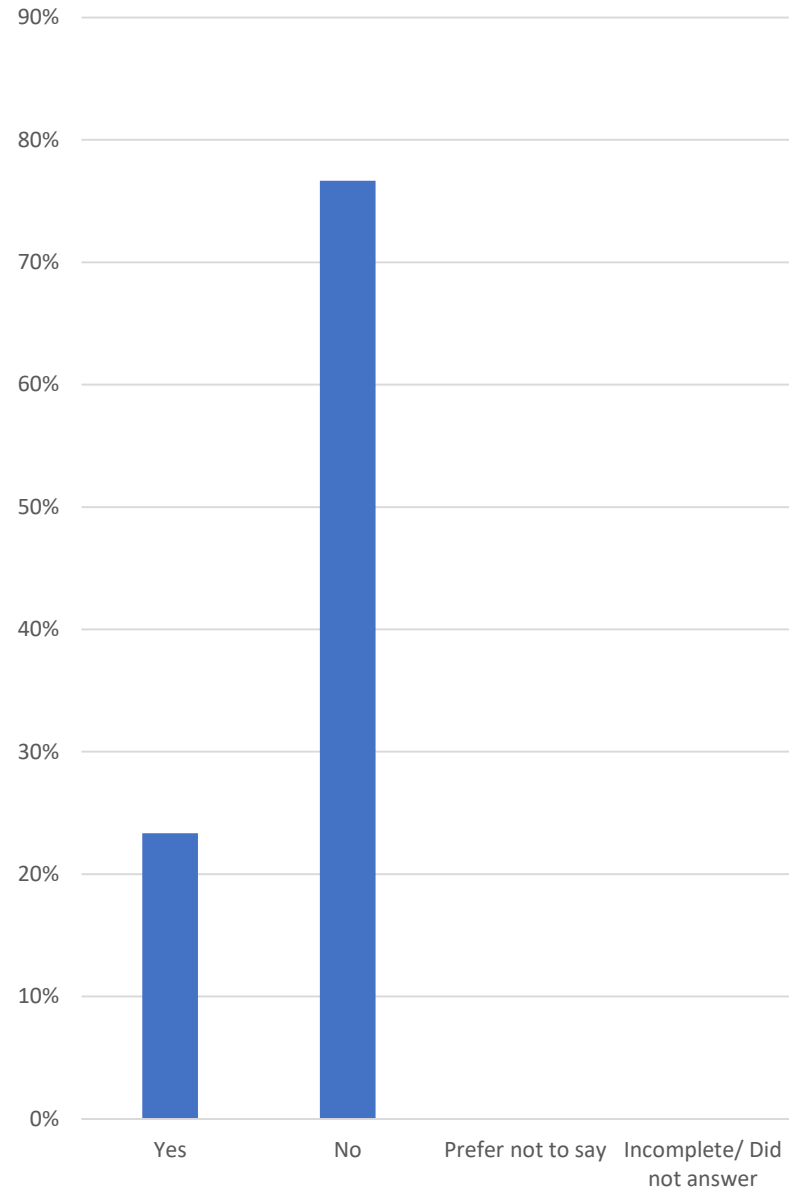
Type of School attended between 11-16
